

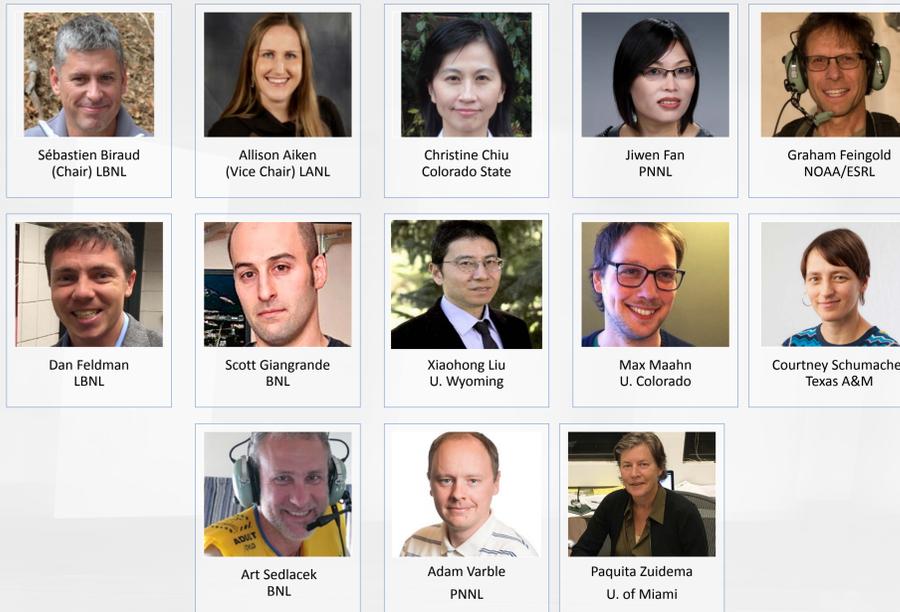
The ARM User Executive Committee: A Voice For the User Community

ARM

The **User Executive Committee (UEC)** is chartered to serve as a liaison between ARM and the user community and to provide feedback to ARM. The UEC is an independent body, whose members are elected for a 4-year term, charged with providing objective, timely advice and recommendations to the leadership of the ARM Program with respect to the user experience.

Who are the UEC members?

UEC members are elected representatives from the ARM user community. We are data users with a wide range of backgrounds and experiences.



Topics Addressed by the UEC in 2018/2019

Outreach across the user community

- Leverage attendance at science and programmatic meetings to reach a larger user community
- Regular column in ARM publications, including introductions to UEC
- Focus on early career scientists, including networking session at this meeting

Improvement of the Data Discovery

- Provided feedback, suggestions and comments on how to improve the data discovery.

Development of ARM tutorials

- Work with ARM staff to define topics for new series of ARM tutorials
- Review drafts before release

Feedback for Biological and Environmental Research Advisory Committee (BERAC)

- BERAC Subcommittee on User Facilities examined how user facilities contribute to Grand Challenges
- UEC prepared a report back to the Subcommittee
